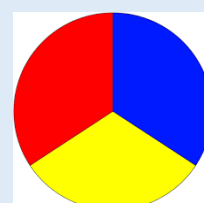
David Hockney is an English painter known for his colourful paintings and prints.

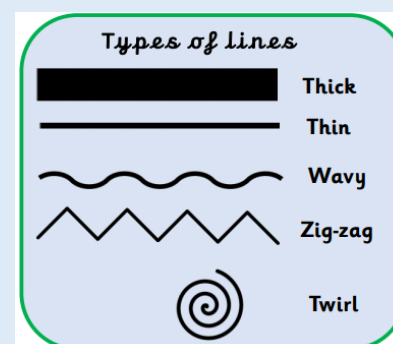

Key Vocabulary

Artist		A person who creates art.
Media		Materials and tools used to create a piece of art e.g. paints, fabric, digital media, etc.
Tone		The lightness or darkness of a colour.
Line		A mark on a surface that joins different points. Lines can vary in width, direction and shape.
Colour		What we see when light bounces off things, like red, yellow, blue, green.
Space		The area in and around objects.
Shape		A flat, 2D areas where lines connect.
Printing		Transferring an image from one surface to another.
Pattern		An element that is repeated within a piece of work; it can be used to add interest and detail.
Texture		How something feels when it is touched.
Collage		A piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper onto a backing.
