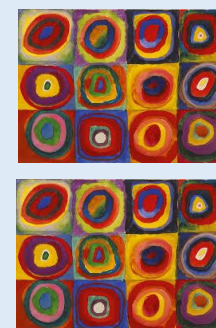


Wassily Kandinsky



Born in 1866, Russia
Style: Abstract

Kandinsky is a Russian artist famous for painting shapes with bright colours. He thought art was like music and he painted how music felt, not what things looked like.



Photography and Digital Art

Using technology such as cameras and computers to take and edit images is a type of digital art. Photography captures real life whereas digital art creates new things on a device.



Sculpture

Sculpture is a type of art that is 3D. They can be made from different materials such as clay, stone and wood. Artists make sculptures by carving, modelling and building.

Modern Art		Artwork that uses bright colours and big shapes. It looks new and creative and doesn't represent exactly how things look in real life.
Abstract Art		Artwork that uses shapes, colours, forms and marks to represent an image.
Tone		The lightness or darkness of a colour.
Line		A mark on a surface that joins different points. Lines can vary in width, direction and shape.
Texture		Texture is how a surface feels, or looks like it feels.
Space		The area in and around objects.
Shape		A flat, 2D areas where lines connect.
Form		Form in art is defined as a three-dimensional object having height, width, and depth.
Primary Colours		Primary colours are red, yellow, and blue. They are the foundation colours that cannot be created by mixing any other colours together
Secondary Colours		Secondary colours are made by mixing two primary colours together in equal parts.
Sculpture		A sculpture is a three-dimensional (3D) piece of art, meaning it has height, width, and depth, unlike a flat drawing.
