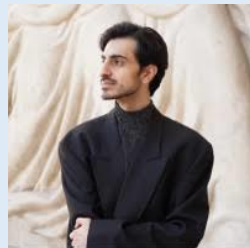
Derek Gores

Style: Fashion art
Edgar Artis is an illustrator who draws fashion figures and uses everyday objects, like fruit, paper clips and flowers to create imaginative clothes designs that look 3D.

Born in 1980, America
Style: Designer/Artist
Virgil Abloh is famous for combining fashion and contemporary art in creative ways for his fashion brand 'Off White'. He has collaborated with brands such as Nike to create minimalist designs shown at exhibitions around the world.

Using old or unwanted materials to create new or improved items.

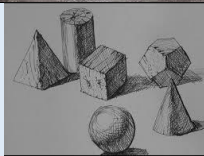
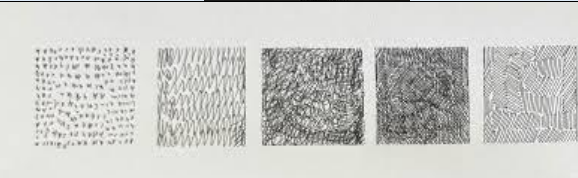
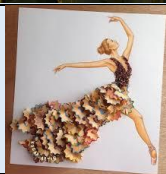
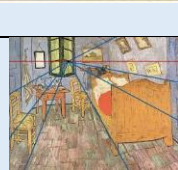


Decoupage

A decorative art from where artists layer glue, paper, images or patterns onto surfaces like wood or canvas and then seal with a varnish.



Key Vocabulary

Visual Texture		How something looks like it would feel.
Highlight		The lightest part of an area.
Form		Form in art is defined as a three-dimensional object having height, width, and depth.
Line		A mark on a surface that joins different points. Lines can vary in width, direction and shape.
Composition		How elements are arranged in a piece of art.
Focal Point		The main part of the artwork that draws attention.
Mixed Media		Combining more than one art material or technique.
Foreground		Part of the picture that appears closest to the viewer,
Background		The background is the area of space in the distance.
Perspective		Animation using clay models.
Proportion		The size relationship between parts of an artwork.
