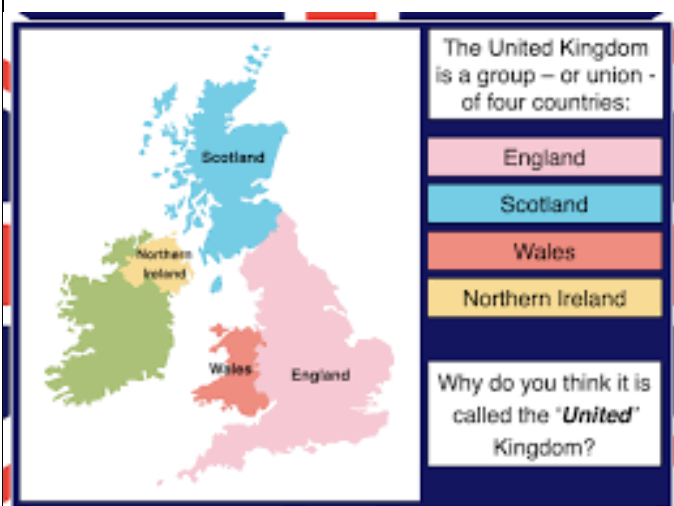

- The capital city of England is London.

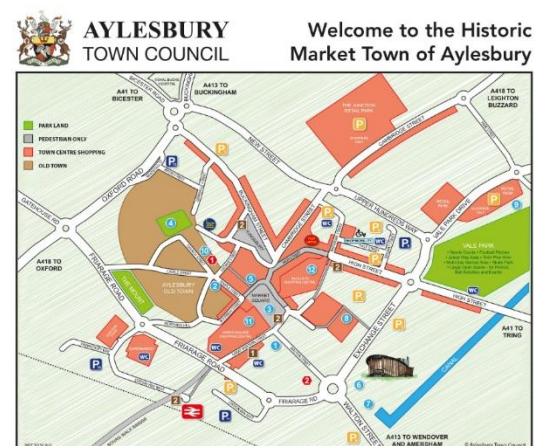
The United Kingdom

Country		A country is a land that is controlled by a single government.
City		A city is a place where many people live closely together. Cities bring together a great variety of people from different backgrounds. They offer more jobs, more schools, and more kinds of activities than smaller towns and villages.
Town		A town is a larger than a village, but smaller than a city. There are houses, shops and schools in a town.
Countryside		Countryside is the land in parts of a country, away from large towns and cities. There is usually a lot of woodland, farms and fields.
Conservation		Conservation means protecting our environment and the wildlife that lives in it so that it is still there in years to come.
Physical geography		Physical features are the natural things that you can see all around you, for example woodland, seas, mountains and rivers.
Human Geography		Human features are things like houses, roads and bridges. They have been built by people.
Map		Maps can be drawings or models. They can help you find where you are and where you are going. They show symbols for places such as car parks or churches.
Endangered species		Endangered animals are species where the number of animals living in the wild is getting less. It means that they are at high risk of dying out in the near future if we don't take any steps to protect them.
