Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope this letter finds you well. We are writing to inform you about an exciting update. One of our Headteachers, Mrs Rachel Lee, will be spending nine days in Ghana this November as she has been asked to teach at a remote village school in partnership with the charity TEABAG (The Education and Book Appeal: Ghana).

In light of this opportunity to make a real difference in part of the world where children have very, very little, we will be having a fundraising Mufti Day on Friday, 7th November. We kindly request that all children participate by wearing non-uniform attire for the day. We ask for a suggested minimum donation of £1 per child in support of the charity TEABAG. Proceeds from this day will go directly to support the educational needs of the school in Ghana, ensuring that Mrs Lee can provide valuable learning resources and assistance during her visit. Staff will be on the school gates with collection buckets before and after school.

We encourage you to discuss this initiative with your child and consider how important it is to support our global community. Your contributions, no matter how small, can make a significant difference in the lives of many children.
