### **Year 6 Visit to Bletchley Park**

As part of the Year 6 autumn term curriculum enquiry question, '**Should we accept our place in society?**' the children in Year 6 will be going on a trip to Bletchley Park. Here they will discover more about the extraordinary achievements of the men and women that worked there during WWII and how their codebreaking skills played a crucial part in the Allied victory.

This trip will take place on **Monday, 25 November 2024**. The coach will depart Elmhurst at 9:10 am, so children must arrive at school promptly. We will be leaving Bletchley at 14:30 pm, so should be back before the end of the school day for a normal pick-up. All children must wear school uniform and will need to bring a packed lunch. Please ensure your child has a drink; however, no fizzy drinks are allowed. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please book a deli option on School Food United for Monday, 25 November 2024 and this will be provided as a packed lunch for them to take on the visit.

The cost of the visit will be **£17.50** per child and a voluntary contribution is required by **Friday, 8 November 2024**. No child will be excluded from this experience if parents cannot afford to contribute; however, if we receive insufficient contributions then we will have no option but to cancel this experience as we cannot provide trips and visits without parental contributions.
